## House Bill 3415

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Imposes 10-year moratorium on use of hydraulic fracturing for oil and gas exploration and production.

2	Relating to hydraulic fracturing.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 520.
5	SECTION 2. (1) A moratorium is imposed until December 31, 2025, on the use of hydraulic
6	fracturing in the exploration for and production of oil and gas in this state.
7	(2) For the purposes of this section, "hydraulic fracturing" means the drilling technique
8	of expanding existing fractures or creating new fractures in rock by injecting water, with
9	or without chemicals, sand or other substances, into or underneath the surface of the rock
