

House Bill 3417

Sponsored by Representatives HELM, HOYLE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires minimum of 30 days' public notice and opportunity to comment period prior to meeting dates of regional solutions advisory committees.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to regional solutions advisory committee meetings; amending section 5, chapter 82, Oregon
3 Laws 2014; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 5, chapter 82, Oregon Laws 2014, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 5.** [*Before the beginning of the 2015 regular legislative session*] **On or before September**
7 **15, 2015**, the Governor and the Director of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall
8 develop a process to provide public notice and the opportunity for public comment, and for consid-
9 eration of public comments, at regional solutions advisory committee meetings where the establish-
10 ment of regional priorities for community and economic development and regional implementation
11 project proposals are being considered. **The process shall provide a minimum of 30 days' notice**
12 **and opportunity for public comment before the date of a regional solutions advisory com-**
13 **mittee meeting.**

14 **SECTION 2.** **This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
16 **on its passage.**
