

# House Bill 3515

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits State Fish and Wildlife Commission from including gray wolf on list of threatened or endangered species.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to listing of gray wolf as threatened or endangered species; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of ORS 496.171 to 496.182, the State Fish and Wildlife Commission may not include the gray wolf on the list of wildlife species that are threatened species or endangered species adopted by rule of the commission pursuant to ORS 496.172.**

**SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.**
