SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Justice for biennial expenses of district attorneys.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the financial administration of the Department of Justice; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium be-**
5 **ginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$11,644,429, for the following**
6 **purposes:**

7 (1) **Paying expenses of district attorneys, as provided in section 2 of this 2015 Act; and**

8 (2) **Paying the expenses incurred in administering this section and section 2 of this 2015**
9 **Act, as provided in section 3 of this 2015 Act.**

10 **SECTION 2. The Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, may**
11 **allocate moneys from the appropriation made by section 1 of this 2015 Act for the payment**
12 **of expenses of district attorneys.**

13 **SECTION 3. The Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, may**
14 **allocate moneys from the appropriation made by section 1 of this 2015 Act for the payment**
15 **of expenses incurred in administering sections 1 and 2 of this 2015 Act.**

16 **SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
18 **July 1, 2015.**
