5	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
6	are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment
7	of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-
8	imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds
9	not described in this section, collected or received by the Oregon Government Ethics Com-
10	mission, for the following purposes:
11	(1) Administration \$ 2,083,828
12	(2) Electronic reporting
13	system \$ 200,000
14	SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
15	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
16	July 1, 2015.

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
