Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For purposes of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following fees for application by an Oregon post-secondary institution to operate under an interstate agreement regarding the provision of post-secondary distance education, adopted by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:
