

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5035

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium
3 beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following
4 purposes:

- 5 (1) Administration..... \$ 66,148,653
6 (2) Property Tax Division..... \$ 12,245,989
7 (3) Personal Tax and Compliance
8 Division \$ 67,083,250
9 (4) Business Division..... \$ 19,664,379
10 (5) Elderly Rental Assistance
11 and Nonprofit Housing
12 for Elderly Persons..... \$ 5,672,000
13 (6) Senior Property Tax Deferral... \$ 373,841
14 (7) Debt Service..... \$ 9,071,030

15 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
16 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment
17 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-
18 imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds
19 not described in this section, collected or received by the Department of Revenue, for the
20 following purposes:

- 21 (1) Administration..... \$ 12,570,956
22 (2) Property Tax Division..... \$ 40,354,202
23 (3) Personal Tax and Compliance
24 Division \$ 1,478,630
25 (4) Business Division..... \$ 15,130,152
26 (5) Multistate Tax Commission \$ 284,945
27 (6) Senior Property Tax Deferral... \$ 31,175,099

28 “**SECTION 3.** (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-
29 propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the
30 General Fund, the amount of \$1,836,836, to be allocated to Department of Revenue for the
31 Property Tax Division.

32 “(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated
33 by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date be-
34 come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

35 “**SECTION 4.** This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

1 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
2 **July 1, 2015.”**
