

A-Engrossed House Bill 5036

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

- Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Secretary of State for certain biennial expenses.
- Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Secretary of State.
- Limits certain biennial expenditures by Secretary of State from federal funds.
- Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation during biennium to Secretary of State for payments to counties for costs associated with maintaining voter registration records.**
- Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Secretary of State; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Secretary of State, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

- (1) **Administrative Services**
- Division \$ 1,805,142**
- (2) **Elections Division \$ 7,322,797**
- (3) **Elections Division -**
- Distribution to counties \$ 384,000**

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Secretary of State, for the following purposes:

- (1) **Administrative Services**
- Division \$ 16,648,868**
- (2) **Elections Division \$ 1,145,964**
- (3) **Audits Division..... \$ 19,982,499**
- (4) **Archives Division..... \$ 7,626,702**
- (5) **Corporation Division..... \$ 9,364,191**

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,251,910 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for

1 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Secretary of State.**

2 **SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
3 **riated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General**
4 **Fund, the amount of \$384,000, to be allocated to the Secretary of State for payments to**
5 **counties for the costs associated with maintaining voter registration records pursuant to**
6 **chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2177).**

7 **(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**
8 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date be-**
9 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

10 **SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
12 **July 1, 2015.**

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
