

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5036

1 Delete lines 4 through 25 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Secretary of State, for the biennium begin-**
3 **ning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- 4 (1) **Administrative Services**
- 5 **Division \$ 1,805,142**
- 6 (2) **Elections Division \$ 7,322,797**
- 7 (3) **Elections Division -**
- 8 **Distribution to counties \$ 384,000**

9 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
10 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment**
11 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
12 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Secretary of State, for**
13 **the following purposes:**

- 14 (1) **Administrative Services**
- 15 **Division \$ 16,648,868**
- 16 (2) **Elections Division \$ 1,145,964**
- 17 (3) **Audits Division..... \$ 19,982,499**
- 18 (4) **Archives Division..... \$ 7,626,702**
- 19 (5) **Corporation Division..... \$ 9,364,191**

20 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
21 **\$6,251,910 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for**
22 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Secretary of State.**

23 **“SECTION 4. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-**
24 **propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the**
25 **General Fund, the amount of \$384,000, to be allocated to the Secretary of State for payments**
26 **to counties for the costs associated with maintaining voter registration records pursuant to**
27 **chapter 8, Oregon Laws 2015 (Enrolled House Bill 2177).**

28 **“(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated**
29 **by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2016, the moneys remaining on that date be-**
30 **come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.**

31 **“SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
32 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
33 **July 1, 2015.”**
