## House Bill 5036

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Secretary of State for certain biennial expenses. Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Secretary of State.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by Secretary of State from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Secretary of State, for the biennium beginning
5	July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:
6	(1) Administrative Services
7	Division \$ 2,627,644
8	(2) Elections Division \$ 8,451,407
9	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
10	are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment
11	of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
12	cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Secretary of State, for
13	the following purposes:
14	(1) Administrative Services

16	(2) Elections Division \$ 1,013,882
17	(3) Audits Division \$ 20,134,619
18	(4) Archives Division \$ 7,616,161

20	SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
21	\$6,641,584 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for
22	payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Secretary of State.
23	SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
24	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
25	July 1, 2015.
