

# Enrolled House Bill 5037

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Department of State Lands; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:**

- (1) **Common School Fund  
programs..... \$ 31,291,047**
- (2) **Oregon Removal-Fill  
Mitigation Fund ..... \$ 1,821,439**
- (3) **South Slough National  
Estuarine Research  
Reserve operations..... \$ 1,962,130**
- (4) **Capital improvements ..... \$ 1,026,250**

**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands, for the following purposes:**

- (1) **Common School Fund  
programs..... \$ 16,829**
- (2) **South Slough National  
Estuarine Research  
Reserve operations..... \$ 1,617,600**

**SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, expenditures by the Department of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges, unclaimed property finders fees and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are not limited.**

**SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.**
