**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Board of Tax Practitioners.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Board of Tax Practitioners; and declaring an  
3 emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
6 **\$1,242,678 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for**  
7 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
8 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Board of Tax**  
9 **Practitioners.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
12 **July 1, 2015.**
