

# House Concurrent Resolution 1

Sponsored by Representative OLSON (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Recognizes and honors Lance Corporal Joseph E. Rodewald (1988-2010) for his service to his country.

## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2       Whereas Lance Corporal Joseph E. Rodewald was born on October 19, 1988, in Eugene, Oregon,  
3 to Jacque Brotherton and John Rodewald; and

4       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald graduated from South Albany High School in 2007 and en-  
5 listed in the Marine Corps upon graduation; and

6       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald had the opportunity to play college football, but said, "I  
7 could handle getting hurt as a Marine and not playing football, but I couldn't handle getting hurt  
8 playing football and not being a Marine"; and

9       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald, who was days away from his 22nd birthday, was killed in  
10 the line of duty on October 13, 2010, after being hit by a roadside bomb in Afghanistan; and

11       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald was well known for his ability to lead by example; and

12       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald lived to serve his country and had high hopes to excel in the  
13 military; and

14       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald will be remembered as the ultimate teammate who encour-  
15 aged others even as he always strove to do his best; and

16       Whereas Lance Corporal Rodewald was the embodiment of Marine Corps ideals; now, therefore,

17 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

18       That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Lance  
19 Corporal Joseph E. Rodewald for his service to his country.
