House Concurrent Resolution 13

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Commemorates 100th anniversary of McKinley Elementary School.

2	Whereas McKinley Elementary School was built in 1915 at a cost of \$25,128; and
3	Whereas McKinley Elementary School was named to honor William McKinley, President of the
4	United States from March 4, 1897, to September 14, 1901; and
5	Whereas approximately 6,000 students have been enrolled and 19 principals have served at
6	McKinley Elementary School since it opened; and
7	Whereas McKinley Elementary School also served as a junior high school early on and later
8	as a community hospital during the Great Pandemic of 1918-1919; and
9	Whereas McKinley Elementary School, built in the stately Tudor Revival style with subsequent
10	additions, is included in the Oregon Historic Sites Database maintained by the State Historic Pres-
11	ervation Office; and
12	Whereas McKinley Elementary School students have demonstrated strong academic success
13	over time as measured by their high performance levels on statewide assessments; and
14	Whereas McKinley Elementary School is a vibrant, active and inclusive community and a won-
15	drous place for learning, with 100 years of special memories and moments and where parent and
16	community volunteers provide unending support, logging approximately 1,500 volunteer hours each
17	year; and
18	Whereas McKinley Elementary School has an adjacent city park that was founded with the help
19	of the South Central Association of Neighbors and the City of Salem; and
20	Whereas artists are invited each year to McKinley Elementary School, often through the Salem
21	Art Association's Artist-in-Residence program, to inspire students' creativity, among them Daniel
22	Dancer, Kiko Denzer and Lynn Takata; and
23	Whereas McKinley Elementary School has a farm-to-school garden under the Oregon Farm-to-
24	School and School Garden Program, allowing students to cultivate curiosity and explore agriculture
25	and sustainability with hands-on experiences; and
26	Whereas in 1997, McKinley Elementary School was the first Salem-Keizer District 24J school
27	to offer a full-day kindergarten program; and

Whereas McKinley Elementary School has made great technological strides since its first days,

from hoisting a white flag outside to indicate the end of recess in 1915 to using tablet computers
