House Concurrent Resolution 13

Sponsored by Representative CLEM, Senator COURTNEY (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Commemorates 100th anniversary of McKinley Elementary School.

2	Whereas McKinley Elementary School was built in 1915 at a cost of \$25,128; and
3	Whereas McKinley Elementary School was named after President William McKinley, whose
4	term spanned the period from March 4, 1897, to his death by assassination on September 14, 1901;
5	and
6	Whereas approximately 6,000 students have been enrolled at McKinley Elementary School since
7	it opened; and
8	Whereas McKinley Elementary School has had 19 principals between 1915 and 2015; and
9	Whereas McKinley Elementary School closed two years after it first opened and was converted
10	to a hospital during the influenza epidemic of 1918; and
11	Whereas additions were made to the McKinley Elementary School building in 1949, 1959, 1978
12	and 1980; and
13	Whereas McKinley Elementary School students have demonstrated strong academic success
14	over time as measured by their high performance levels on statewide assessments; and
15	Whereas parent volunteers provide unending support for McKinley Elementary School, logging
16	approximately 1,500 volunteer hours annually; and
17	Whereas McKinley Elementary School entered into an agreement to purchase additional land
18	to improve its grounds with the help of the South Central Association of Neighbors; and
19	Whereas artists-in-residence are invited to McKinley Elementary School each year to inspire
20	students' creativity, and these artists have included Daniel Dancer, Kiko Denzer and Lynn Takata;
21	and
22	Whereas McKinley Elementary School has a farm-to-school garden, which allows students to
23	explore agriculture and sustainability with hands-on experiences; and
24	Whereas in 1997, McKinley Elementary School was the first school in the Salem-Keizer School
25	District to offer a full-day kindergarten program; and
26	Whereas McKinley Elementary School has made great technological strides since its first days,
27	from hanging a white flag outside to indicate the end of recess in 1915 to implementing the use of
28	tablet computers and interactive whiteboards in 2014; now, therefore,
29	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
30	That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, commemorate the 100th an-
31	niversary of McKinley Elementary School.
