Whereas Army Specialist Taylor Marks moved to Monmouth and graduated from Central High School in 2008; and

Whereas Army Specialist Taylor Marks enlisted in the Oregon National Guard after high school as a linguist specialist; and

Whereas Army Specialist Taylor Marks planned to enroll in the University of Oregon to study finance and Japanese; and

Whereas Army Specialist Taylor Marks enjoyed geocaching, music and spending time with his friends, loved to learn and approached life as an adventure; and

Whereas Army Specialist Taylor Marks was deployed to Iraq on June 19, 2009, with the 41st Infantry Brigade Combat Team; and

Whereas Army Specialist Taylor Marks died on August 28, 2009, from wounds sustained in an attack by insurgents in Rashid, Iraq; now, therefore,

**Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**

That we, the members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Army Specialist Taylor Daniel Marks for his service to his country.
