

House Concurrent Resolution 5

Sponsored by Representative WHITSETT, Senator WHITSETT (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Honors Coach Daniel J. "Danny" Miles for his career and achievements.

2 Whereas Daniel J. "Danny" Miles is a native of Medford, Oregon, and has been the men's bas-
3 ketball head coach at the Oregon Institute of Technology for 44 seasons; and

4 Whereas in his 43rd season, Coach Miles earned his 1,000th win for the Hustlin' Owls; and

5 Whereas Coach Miles holds a 1,004-412 win-loss record; and

6 Whereas Coach Miles has led the Hustlin' Owls to three National Association of Intercollegiate
7 Athletics (NAIA) Division II national championships in 2004, 2008 and 2012; and

8 Whereas from 2009 to 2012, Coach Miles led the Hustlin' Owls to an unprecedented four straight
9 Cascade Collegiate Conference regular season championships, along with four straight Cascade
10 Collegiate Conference tournament crowns; and

11 Whereas Coach Miles has led the Hustlin' Owls to 10 seasons of 30 or more wins; and

12 Whereas under Coach Miles' leadership, the Hustlin' Owls have made 14 trips to the NAIA Di-
13 vision II national championships; and

14 Whereas Coach Miles was named the NAIA National Basketball Coach of the Year in 2004 and
15 2008; and

16 Whereas Coach Miles has been named NAIA District II All-Sports Coach of the Year on three
17 occasions; and

18 Whereas Coach Miles was the winner of NAIA's Champion of Character award in 2009; and

19 Whereas Coach Miles was honored at the Oregon Sports Awards as the Slat Gill All-Sport
20 Coach of the Year for 2004 and with the DNA Award for 2012; and

21 Whereas in 2013, Coach Miles received the National Association of Basketball Coaches Guard-
22 ians of the Game Award for Advocacy; and

23 Whereas in 2005 Coach Miles was honored by his alma mater, Southern Oregon University, as
24 the recipient of the Distinguished Alumnus Award; and

25 Whereas Coach Miles was inducted into the NAIA Hall of Fame in March 2001; and

26 Whereas in 1996, Coach Miles was inducted into the Oregon Sports Hall of Fame; and

27 Whereas in 2011 Coach Miles was selected to serve as a court coach for the International
28 Basketball Federation (FIBA) Men's U19 Junior National Team in Colorado Springs, Colorado, from
29 which the 12-member team that represented the United States at the 2011 FIBA U19 World Cham-
30 pionship was selected; and

31 Whereas in 2010 Coach Miles traveled with other Athletes in Action (AIA) staff to Kenya and
32 Rwanda to host basketball clinics and in August 2011 was selected as Head Clinician for AIA; and

1 Whereas Coach Miles has announced that he will retire in 2016; now, therefore,
