## **House Joint Memorial 5**

Sponsored by Representative READ (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Urges Congress to reauthorize Build America Bonds program to allow states and local governments to finance infrastructure in most efficient manner.

1	JOINT MEMORIAL
2	To the President of the United States, the Senate and the House of Representatives of the United
3	States of America, in Congress assembled, the Secretary of Commerce and the Secretary of the
4	Treasury:
5	We, your memorialists, the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in leg-
6	islative session assembled, respectfully represent as follows:
7	Whereas robust and well-maintained infrastructure for transportation, energy, water, communi-
8	cations and other utilities is vital to the economic well-being and quality of life of every American;
9	and
10	Whereas states and local governments are expected to issue nearly \$350 billion in bond financ-
11	ing in 2014; and
12	Whereas limiting the financing options of these issuers leads to higher costs to taxpayers and
13	market inefficiencies; and
14	Whereas the Build America Bonds program has historically increased the efficiency of
15	infrastructure financing by providing a wider range of market-based options than traditional bonds;
16	and
17	Whereas the subsidy rate of the Build America Bonds program can be adjusted so as to have a
18	fiscally neutral effect on the federal budget in the long term; and
19	Whereas more efficient financing can result in more American jobs and improved domestic
20	infrastructure; and
21	Whereas lowered interest rates means more savings to taxpayers; now, therefore,
22	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
23	(1) The Congress of the United States is respectfully urged to reauthorize the Build America
24	Bonds program in order to allow states and local governments to finance their infrastructure in the
25	most efficient manner available.
26	(2) A copy of this memorial shall be sent to the President of the United States, to the Secretary
27	of Commerce, to the Secretary of the Treasury and to each member of the Oregon Congressional
