SUMMARY

In memoriam: Janice Scroggins, 1955-2014.

2	Whereas Janice Scroggins was born to Henry Hawkins Scroggins and Mary Howard in Idabel,
3	Oklahoma, on July 17, 1955; and
4	Whereas Janice Scroggins began playing the piano when she was three years old, encouraged
5	and taught by her mother and grandmother; and
6	Whereas Janice Scroggins settled in the Albina community in Portland in 1979 with her young
7	daughter, performing in church venues, community establishments, schools and restaurants; and
8	Whereas Janice Scroggins built her reputation as a versatile musician, performing in genres
9	such as jazz, funk, gospel, country, blues and folk; and
10	Whereas Janice Scroggins received a Grammy nomination for her 1987 recording, "Janice
11	Scroggins Plays Scott Joplin," which showcased her unique interpretation of ragtime classics; and
12	Whereas Janice Scroggins collaborated frequently with other artists and was often sought out
13	to perform with friends such as Linda Hornbuckle, Eddie Harris, Akbar DePriest, Reggie Houston
14	and Curtis Salgado; and
15	Whereas Janice Scroggins was inducted into the Muddy Award Hall of Fame in 1992 and the
16	Oregon Music Hall of Fame in 2013; and
17	Whereas Janice Scroggins mentored and supported people from many different ethnic and eco-
18	nomic backgrounds through teaching and performing, and was a go-to session musician who could
19	jam with anyone; and
20	Whereas Janice Scroggins passed away on May 27, 2014; and
21	Whereas Janice Scroggins is a legend whose legacy will continue in the hearts and memories
22	of her friends, family and colleagues and in the mesmerizing music that was her gift to the world;
