HOUSE RESOLUTION

Whereas Wayne Oberding was born January 31, 1925, in Nucla, Colorado; and

Whereas Wayne Oberding served in the United States Navy during World War II; and

Whereas with his wife, Lucille, Wayne Oberding had three children; and

Whereas Wayne Oberding worked as a civil engineer for the City of Portland and the Department of Transportation; and

Whereas Wayne Oberding helped in the design of highways all across the State of Oregon; and

Whereas Wayne Oberding passed away on March 1, 2015, in Portland, at the age of 90; and

Whereas Wayne Oberding is survived by his wife, Lucille, his son Brian, his daughters, Toni and Lisa, and two grandchildren; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Oregon:

That we, the members of the House of Representatives of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly, honor the life of Wayne Oberding and his invaluable service to the people of this state; and be it further
