CHAPTER	

AN ACT

Relating to highways; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "transportation facility" means any physical facility that moves or assists in the movement of people or goods.

- (2) The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall adopt rules or amend existing rules as necessary to allow a city or county to propose transportation improvements located outside of that city or county when the city or county is considering an amendment to a functional plan, comprehensive plan or land use regulation and the amendment would significantly affect a transportation facility within the city or county.
- (3) A city or county may use highway mobility targets established for a highway corridor by the Department of Transportation's Oregon Highway Plan as the basis for proposing transportation improvements located outside of that city or county.

SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation and the Department of Land Conservation and Development shall jointly submit a report describing the implementation of section 1 of this 2015 Act in the manner provided in ORS 192.245 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to transportation no later than September 16, 2016.

SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
