SUMMARY

Requires Department of Human Services to report to Legislative Assembly concerning needed legislative changes by September 1, 2015.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2 Relating to programs administered by the Department of Human Services; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> No later than September 1, 2015, the Department of Human Services shall,

6 in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, report to the Legislative Assembly any legislative

7 changes that must be made during the 2016 regular session of the Legislative Assembly to

8 the statutory laws governing programs administered by the department.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 10 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect

11 on its passage.
