## AN ACT

Relating to the authority of the Department of State Police to enter into real property agreements; amending ORS 181.090; and declaring an emergency.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

**SECTION 1.** ORS 181.090 is amended to read:

181.090. (1) The Superintendent of State Police may establish headquarters and patrol stations at such places as the superintendent considers advisable for the patrol and protection of this state and the enforcement of the laws.

- (2) For purposes of this section, the superintendent may use lands and buildings for the accommodation of members of the state police and their vehicles and equipment.
- (3) The Department of State Police may enter into such lease agreements and take title to such real property as the superintendent considers necessary for the performance of the duties of the department and the Oregon State Police.

SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
