CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to patrolling by county law enforcement officials; repealing section 3, chapter 75, Oregon Laws 2012; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 3, chapter 75, Oregon Laws 2012, as amended by section 3, chapter 479, Oregon Laws 2013, is repealed.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
