SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows Water Resources Department to issue grants to assist recipient entities in preparation of place-based integrated water resources strategies. Authorizes department to provide technical assistance and information to assist entity in preparing place-based integrated water resources strategy. Authorizes Water Resources Commission to adopt rules.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to place-based integrated water resources strategies; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Water Resources Department may issue grants from available 5 moneys to assist in the preparation of place-based integrated water resources strategies that

6 are consistent with Oregon water resources policy and department requirements. The de-

7 partment may issue grants under this subsection to:

8 (a) A person;

9 (b) A public body as defined in ORS 174.109;

10 (c) A department or agency of the United States; or

11 (d) An Indian tribe.

(2) The department may enter into contracts or agreements and provide technical assistance and information to assist a person, public body as defined in ORS 174.109, department or agency of the United States or Indian tribe in preparing a place-based integrated

15 water resources strategy.

(3) The Water Resources Commission may adopt rules for the administration of this
section.

18 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 20 on its passage.
