

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 266

By COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

1 Delete lines 4 through 17 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 536.**

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, ‘place-based integrated water resources’ means**  
4 **waters that are from sources within a single drainage basin or within an area that is a**  
5 **subset of a single drainage basin.**

6 **“(2) The Water Resources Department may issue grants from available moneys to facil-**  
7 **itate the preparation of place-based integrated water resources strategies that are consistent**  
8 **with state laws concerning the water resources of this state, state water resources policy**  
9 **and department requirements. The department may issue grants under this subsection to:**

10 **“(a) A person;**

11 **“(b) A public body as defined in ORS 174.109; or**

12 **“(c) An Indian tribe.**

13 **“(3) The department may enter into contracts or agreements with, and provide technical**  
14 **assistance and information to, a person, a public body as defined in ORS 174.109 or an Indian**  
15 **tribe for the development of place-based integrated water resources strategies.**

16 **“(4) Place-based integrated water resources strategies described in subsections (2) and**  
17 **(3) of this section must:**

18 **“(a) Be developed in collaboration with a balanced representation of interests;**

19 **“(b) Balance current and future in-stream and out-of-stream needs;**

20 **“(c) Include the development of actions that are consistent with the existing state laws**  
21 **concerning the water resources of this state and state water resources policy;**

22 **“(d) Facilitate implementation of local solutions;**

23 **“(e) Be developed utilizing an open and transparent process that fosters public partic-**  
24 **ipation; and**

25 **“(f) Be developed in consultation with the department.**

26 **“(5) The Water Resources Commission may adopt rules for the administration of this**  
27 **section.**

28 **“SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed July 1, 2019.**

29 **“(2) The repeal of section 2 of this 2015 Act does not affect any rights or responsibilities**  
30 **established in a grant, contract or agreement made under section 2 of this 2015 Act prior to**  
31 **July 1, 2019.”**

32 In line 18, delete “2” and insert “4”.
