

# Senate Bill 3

Sponsored by Senator COURTNEY (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of endangering person protected by Family Abuse Prevention Act restraining order. Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to protective orders in Family Abuse Prevention Act proceedings.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 163.160 to**  
5 **163.208.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the crime of endangering a person protected by a**  
7 **Family Abuse Prevention Act restraining order if the person:**

8 (a) **Has been served with the order as provided in ORS 107.718, unless service was waived**  
9 **under ORS 107.720 because the person appeared before the court;**

10 (b) **Intentionally engaged in conduct prohibited by the order while the order was in effect;**  
11 **and**

12 (c) **By engaging in the prohibited conduct, recklessly created a substantial risk of phys-**  
13 **ical injury to a person protected by the order, or intentionally attempted to place a person**  
14 **protected by the order in fear of imminent physical injury.**

15 (2) **Endangering a person protected by a Family Abuse Prevention Act restraining order**  
16 **is a Class C felony.**

17 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies only to conduct occurring on or after the**  
18 **effective date of this 2015 Act.**
