Senate Bill 323

Sponsored by Senator BEYER, Representative DOHERTY; Senator MONROE) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Instructs Oregon Institute of Occupational Health Sciences to conduct study related to provision of medical services in workers' compensation claims. Requires that report be submitted to Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee and Legislative Assembly by July 1, 2016. Mandates payment of expenses for study from funds continuously appropriated to institute.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to studies on the provision of medical services in workers' compensation claims.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Institute of Occupational Health Sciences created under ORS 353.460 shall conduct a study on the cost and clinical outcomes of workers' compensation claims, including but not limited to the cost of medical services provided, in which:
 - (a) Any physician licensed in this state is authorized to participate in the provision of medical services by a managed care organization and chiropractic or naturopathic physicians serve as the attending physician for the life of the claim providing medical services to injured workers; and
 - (b) Medical services to an injured worker are not provided by a managed care organization and chiropractic or naturopathic physicians serve as the attending physician for an injured worker for the life of the claim, compared to the cost and clinical outcomes of claims in which other physicians serve as the attending physician.
 - (2) The study required by subsection (1) of this section shall be submitted to the Workers' Compensation Management-Labor Advisory Committee appointed under ORS 656.790 and to the Legislative Assembly in the manner specified in ORS 192.245 by July 1, 2016.
 - (3) Costs for the study required by subsection (1) of this section shall be paid from moneys continuously appropriated to the Oregon Institute of Occupational Health Sciences under ORS 656.630.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2017.

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
