## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals state preemption of charter and statutory authority of local governments to set minimum wage requirements.

Declares and emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state preemption of local authority to set minimum wage standards; repealing ORS  
3 653.017; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 653.017 is repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
7 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect  
8 on its passage.**
