SUMMARY

Prohibits court and parties to criminal case from charging fees unless expressly authorized by law.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to fees in criminal cases.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) A court shall not order any fee in a criminal case unless the imposition,**
5 **payment or collection of the fee is expressly authorized by law.**

6 **(2) A party to a criminal case shall not charge a fee against or collect a fee from another**
7 **party in the case, unless the charging, payment or collection of the fee is expressly author-**
8 **ized by law.**
