SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Law Commission to study and make recommendations to modernize probate and trust estates laws. Requires report to Legislative Assembly on or before December 31, 2015. Sunsets on June 30, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to estates; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Law Commission shall study and make recommendations for the

5 modernization of laws in ORS chapters 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116 and 117 regarding probate 6 and trust estates.

7 (2) The commission shall report on the study and recommendations to a committee or

8 interim committee of the Legislative Assembly with subject matter jurisdiction over the ju9 diciary before December 31, 2015.

10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on June 30, 2016.

11 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
