Senate Bill 444

Sponsored by Senator STEINER HAYWARD (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Housing and Community Services Department to submit report related to housing stabilization programs to interim legislative committees no later than July 1, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to housing; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) No later than July 1, 2016, the Housing and Community Services Department shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees that have authority over the subject area of housing regarding the following:
 - (a) A description of the type and availability of housing stabilization programs in Oregon;
 - (b) A statement of the policies made and implemented with respect to each program for which the department is responsible, including the relative priority of each program with respect to other programs undertaken by the department;
 - (c) Existing or recommended outcome metrics for each program; and
 - (d) Recommendations for how outcomes might improve with collaboration with the Oregon Health Authority and the Department of Human Services.
 - (2) When preparing the report, the department shall consult with the Oregon Health Authority and the Department of Human Services.
 - SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
