

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 473

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 4, after “352.002” delete the rest of the line.
2 In line 5, delete “institution of higher education that operates in this state”.
3 In line 8, delete “or community college”.
4 In line 15, delete “and community colleges”.
5 In line 19, delete “and community colleges”.
6 Delete lines 22 through 25.
7 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 9 and insert:
8 **“SECTION 2. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, to the extent al-**
9 **lowed by federal law, each public university listed in ORS 352.002:**
10 **“(a) Shall permit enrolled students to use a preferred first name other than the student’s**
11 **legal first name on course and grade rosters, directory listings, advisor lists, identification**
12 **cards and diplomas; and**
13 **“(b) May permit enrolled students to use a preferred first name other than the student’s**
14 **legal first name on campus records not listed in paragraph (a) of this subsection.**
15 **“(2) Public universities listed in ORS 352.002 must use the legal first name of enrolled**
16 **students on official transcripts and enrollment verification documents.”.**
17 In line 11, delete “on or after”.
18 Delete line 12 and insert “for the 2016-2017 academic year.”.
19 In line 13, delete “, community college or other institution of higher education”.
20 In line 16, delete “or community college”.
21 After line 18, insert:
22 **“SECTION 4. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall work with repre-**
23 **sentatives from community colleges to:**
24 **“(a) Determine the best method for community colleges to administer the collection of**
25 **sexual orientation identification data that is voluntarily provided by students, faculty and**
26 **staff;**
27 **“(b) Determine the best method for community colleges to implement policies permitting**
28 **enrolled students to use preferred names on certain college documents; and**
29 **“(c) Identify potential barriers to carrying out the activities described in paragraphs (a)**
30 **and (b) of this subsection, including legal issues, cost issues and data system limitations.**
31 **“(2) The commission shall report its conclusions on the most cost effective and least**
32 **burdensome methods of carrying out the activities described in subsection (1)(a) and (b) of**
33 **this section to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to higher educa-**
34 **tion no later than May 31, 2016.**
35 **“SECTION 5. Section 4 of this 2015 Act is repealed on July 1, 2016.**

1 **“SECTION 6. (1) The requirements set forth in sections 1 to 3 of this 2015 Act first apply**
2 **to the 2016-2017 academic year.**

3 **“(2) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission and public universities listed in ORS**
4 **352.002 may take any action before the 2016-2017 academic year that is necessary to enable**
5 **the commission and universities to exercise, during and after the 2016-2017 academic year,**
6 **all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the commission and universities by**
7 **sections 1 to 3 of this 2015 Act.”.**

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
