

Senate Bill 485

Sponsored by Senator EDWARDS (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits public body from publishing on Internet amount of tax court judgment if amount of judgment is less than \$50,000.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to judgments of the Oregon Tax Court; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. A public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, may not publish on the Internet**
5 **the amount of a judgment entered in the Oregon Tax Court if the amount of the judgment**
6 **is less than \$50,000.**

7 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
9 **on its passage.**
