SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Requires Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish] **Establishes** uniform standards for hand dryers installed in public restrooms, including standards that impose limit on decibel level of operating hand dryer.

2	Relating to hand dryers.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2015 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.
5	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "hand dryer" means an electrical device that
6	blows air for the purpose of allowing a user of the device to dry the user's hands.
7	(2) A hand dryer installed in a restroom that is available for use by the public:
8	(a) Must operate at a noise level of not more than 84 decibels, as determined by the
9	manufacturer of the hand dryer; and
10	(b) If the hand dryer is capable of blowing air downward, may not blow air at an air ve-
11	locity that exceeds 115 miles per hour, as determined by the manufacturer of the hand dryer.
