Senate Bill 5

Sponsored by Senator COURTNEY, Representative KOMP (at the request of the Tebeau family) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that portion of State Highway 126 between Florence and Eugene shall be known as William Tebeau Memorial Highway.

2	Relating to State Highway 126.
3	Whereas William "Bill" Tebeau was born and raised in Baker City, Oregon; and
4	Whereas Bill Tebeau was the first male African-American to attend Oregon State College and
5	graduated from the college in 1948 with a Bachelor of Science in chemical engineering; and
6	Whereas Bill Tebeau had a diverse career with the Department of Transportation surveying,
7	planning, designing highways and bridges, training many future civil engineers and managing the
8	department's first hydraulic design unit; and
9	Whereas Bill Tebeau retired from the department in 1984 after 36 years of service; and
10	Whereas, during his career, Bill Tebeau conducted preliminary studies of 21 bridges on the
11	Florence-Eugene Highway in less than a year in preparation for the construction of the Fern Ridge
12	Reservoir; and
13	Whereas Bill Tebeau was a part-time instructor at Chemeketa Community College for 30 years
14	teaching engineering-related courses, including thermal dynamics, physics, surveying, chemistry,
15	math and economics; and
16	Whereas in 1970 Bill Tebeau was named "Teacher of the Year" by Chemeketa Community Col-
17	lege; and
18	Whereas in 2008 Bill Tebeau was the first recipient of the Oregon Northwest Black Pioneers
19	Trailblazer Award as a pioneer excelling in his field and as an example of courage, determination,
20	resilience and service; and
21	Whereas in 2010 Bill Tebeau was inducted into Oregon State University's Engineering Hall of
22	Fame; now, therefore,
23	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
24	SECTION 1. (1) The portion of State Highway 126, known as the Florence-Eugene High-
25	way, beginning where the highway intersects with U.S. Highway 101 in Florence and ending
26	where it intersects with Oregon Route 569, the Beltline Highway, in Eugene, shall also be
27	known as the William Tebeau Memorial Highway.
28	(2) The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain suitable markers along
29	the highway described in this section indicating the designation of the highway as the

William Tebeau Memorial Highway.
