Senate Bill 524

Sponsored by Senators KNOPP, MONNES ANDERSON, WINTERS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires health care facility to provide to patient or resident, in writing and within 12 hours of admission, facility's policy, if any, concerning provision of life-sustaining procedures that are not likely to benefit patient's or resident's medical condition.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to life-sustaining procedures.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "health care facility" has the meaning given that 5 term in ORS 442.015.

6 (2) A health care facility that has a policy concerning the provision of life-sustaining 7 procedures that are not likely to benefit a patient's or resident's medical condition shall 8 make the policy available in writing. The facility must provide the written policy to any pa-9 tient or resident who is admitted to the facility within 12 hours of the admission.

(3) If the patient or resident is a minor child, the health care facility shall provide the
written policy to a parent or legal guardian of the minor child.

(4) This section does not require a health care facility to establish or maintain a policy
concerning the provision of life-sustaining procedures that are not likely to benefit a
patient's or resident's medical condition.

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
