Senate Bill 535

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that public body has no responsibility to post warnings related to dangers of ocean. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to the liability of public bodies for injuries related to the ocean; and declaring an emer-
3	gency.
4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. A public body as defined in ORS 174.109 and its officers, employees and
6	agents have no responsibility to post warnings related to the dangers of the ocean, including
7	but not limited to tides, currents, ocean life and collisions with watercraft.
8	SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
