

Senate Bill 535

Sponsored by Senators GIROD, ROBLAN, KRUSE, JOHNSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that public body has no responsibility to post warnings related to dangers of ocean.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the liability of public bodies for injuries related to the ocean; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. A public body as defined in ORS 174.109 and its officers, employees and**
6 **agents have no responsibility to post warnings related to the dangers of the ocean, including**
7 **but not limited to tides, currents, ocean life and collisions with watercraft.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
