2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium be-
3 ginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following pur-

17 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
18 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Justice,
19 for the following purposes:

- 22 (2) Appellate Division \$ 18,620,859
- 23 (3) Civil Enforcement Division \$ 73,400,097

- 27 (6) General Counsel Division \$ 47,707,931
- 28 (7) Trial Division \$ 29,489,282
- 29 (8) Child Support Division \$ 28,518,332

30 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
31 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment
32 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Department of Justice for the
33 following purposes:
