SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Bureau of Labor and Industries for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by bureau.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Limits biennial expenditures by bureau from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Bureau of Labor and Industries; and declaring an 3 emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

 $\mathbf{5}$ SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$12,309,578.

7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 8 \$8,970,290 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for 9 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Bureau of Labor 10

11 and Industries.

12 SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 13\$1,935,599 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for 14 payment of administrative expenses by the Bureau of Labor and Industries from the Wage 15 Security Fund.

(2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, expenditures by the Bureau of Labor and 16 17 Industries for wage claim payments from the Wage Security Fund are not limited.

18 SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,481,005 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for 19 20 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Bureau of Labor and 21 Industries.

22 SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 23peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 24 July 1, 2015.
