

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5518

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for**
3 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for**
4 **payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee, for the following**
5 **purposes:**

6 (1) General program..... \$ 25,564,143

7 (2) Debt service..... \$ 9,326,961

8 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
9 **\$2,225,416 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for**
10 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
11 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-**
12 **ministration Committee.**

13 **“SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, expenditures by the Legislative**
14 **Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies**
15 **Stores Account established by ORS 173.790 are not limited.**

16 **“SECTION 4. There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-**
17 **ning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$12,905,395 for payment of the ex-**
18 **penditures of the following offices:**

19 **“(1) The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-**
20 **sentatives;**

21 **“(2) The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the House of Representatives;**
22 **and**

23 **“(3) The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Rep-**
24 **resentatives.**

25 **“SECTION 5. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium**
26 **beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$17,237,580 for payment of the**
27 **expenses of members of the Seventy-eighth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.**

28 **“(2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July**
29 **1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$9,022,377 for payment of the expenses of**
30 **members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.**

31 **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
32 **\$225,352 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for**
33 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
34 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative As-**
35 **sembly.**

1 **“SECTION 7.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, expenditures by the Legislative
2 Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account established by ORS 171.117 for the costs of
3 food served in members’ lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or
4 by payroll deductions from members are not limited.

5 **“SECTION 8.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
6 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$10,855,246.

7 **“SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
8 \$1,515,091 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for
9 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
10 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
11 Committee.

12 **“SECTION 10.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, expenditures by the Legislative
13 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established by ORS 171.305 and from
14 the Legislative Publications Account established by ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
15 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
16 Statutes, are not limited.

17 **“SECTION 11.** (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
18 beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,330,986.

19 **“(2)** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$3,443,858 is es-
20 tablished for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-
21 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
22 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Fiscal Office.

23 **“SECTION 12.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
24 beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,417,874.

25 **“SECTION 13.** There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
26 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$401,939.

27 **“SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$6,784
28 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of
29 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
30 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian
31 Services.

32 **“SECTION 15.** This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
33 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect
34 July 1, 2015.”.
