

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5525

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

June 29

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department,  
3 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for  
4 the following purposes:

5 (1) Oregon Arts Commission..... \$ 4,115,924

6 (2) Debt service ..... \$ 9,136,630

7 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
8 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment  
9 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
10 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Business Devel-  
11 opment Department, for the following purposes:

12 (1) Business, innovation  
13 and trade..... \$ 11,275,365

14 (2) Infrastructure  
15 Finance Authority..... \$ 38,245,147

16 (3) Shared services..... \$ 1,758,455

17 (4) Arts and Cultural Trust ..... \$ 8,260,870

18 (5) Lottery bond debt service..... \$ 400,000

19 (6) Regional Solutions ..... \$ 6,335,000

20 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
21 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment  
22 of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic De-  
23 velopment Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following pur-  
24 poses:

25 (1) Business, innovation  
26 and trade..... \$ 53,965,847

27 (2) Shared services..... \$ 7,094,851

28 (3) Oregon Film and Video Office .. \$ 1,164,460

29 (4) Lottery bond debt service..... \$ 45,114,206

30 (5) Regional Solutions ..... \$ 1,000,000

31 (6) Infrastructure  
32 Finance Authority..... \$ 1,031,462

33 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
34 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment  
35 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development

1 Department, for the following purposes:

- 2 (1) Business, innovation  
3 and trade..... \$ 5,431,959
- 4 (2) Infrastructure Finance  
5 Authority ..... \$ 32,449,251
- 6 (3) Shared services..... \$ 197,214
- 7 (4) Arts..... \$ 1,891,318

8 **“SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, expenditures by the Oregon Busi-**  
9 **ness Development Department are not limited for:**

10 **“(1) Loans from the following funds:**

11 **“(a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon Entrepreneurial Devel-**  
12 **opment Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit Enhancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and**  
13 **Brownfields Redevelopment Fund (ORS 285A.188); and**

14 **“(b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS 285B.563), Marine**  
15 **Navigation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708)**  
16 **and Safe Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213).**

17 **“(2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds and general obligation**  
18 **bonds.**

19 **“SECTION 6. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
20 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
21 **July 1, 2015.”.**
