Senate Bill 5528

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Parks and Recreation Department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

- SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$912,494 25

- opment Fund to the State Parks and Recreation Department for the payment of debt service 28

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Parks and Recreation Department for the following purposes:

- (1) Park development \$ 1,679,158
- 7 (2) Direct services...... \$ 2,047,540
- 8 (3) Community support and grants \$ 7,350,687

SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect July 1, 2015.

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
