sage grouse conservation efforts.

Limits biennial expenditures for payment of expenses of sage grouse conservation efforts by State Department of Fish and Wildlife from grant from Intermountain West Joint Venture.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-4

ated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out 5

of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000 for the wolf depredation compensation and fi-6

nancial assistance grant program. 7

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-8 ated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, 9 10 out of the General Fund, the amount of \$90,000 for sage grouse conservation efforts.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$90,000 11 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of 12expenses for sage grouse conservation efforts from moneys or other revenues collected or 13 received by the State Department of Fish and Wildlife from a grant from the Intermountain 14 West Joint Venture. 15

SECTION 4. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 16 17 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect 18 July 1, 2015.
