

Senate Bill 566

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON FINANCE AND REVENUE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on Data Centers. Requires task force to examine issues related to data centers in Oregon. Authorizes task force to pre-session file legislation. Requires task force to report to Legislative Assembly during 2016 regular session.

Sunsets task force on December 31, 2016.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to data centers; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Data Centers is established, consisting of eight**
5 **members appointed as follows:**

6 (a) **The President of the Senate shall appoint four members from among members of the**
7 **Senate.**

8 (b) **The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint four members from among**
9 **members of the House of Representatives.**

10 (2) **The task force shall examine issues related to data centers in Oregon, including how**
11 **data center property should be assessed for purposes of property taxation and whether the**
12 **property is, or should be considered, the property of a company described in ORS 308.515 that**
13 **performs the business of communication as defined in ORS 308.505.**

14 (3) **A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the transaction**
15 **of business.**

16 (4) **Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**
17 **of the task force.**

18 (5) **The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

19 (6) **If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
20 **ment to become immediately effective.**

21 (7) **The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
22 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

23 (8) **The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

24 (9) **The task force may pre-session file legislation in the manner provided in ORS 171.130**
25 **for interim committees. All legislation recommended by official action of the task force must**
26 **indicate that it is introduced at the request of the task force.**

27 (10) **The task force shall report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in**
28 **ORS 192.245 at any time during the 2016 regular session of the Legislative Assembly that the**
29 **President and Speaker may designate.**

30 (11) **The task force shall be staffed by the Legislative Revenue Officer.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 **(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
2 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
3 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
4 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

5 **SECTION 2.** **Section 1 of this 2015 Act is repealed on December 31, 2016.**

6 **SECTION 3.** **This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
7 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
8 **on its passage.**
