

# B-Engrossed Senate Bill 606

Ordered by the Senate June 30  
Including Senate Amendments dated April 7 and June 30

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON, Representative KENY-GUYER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Extends dental pilot project by seven years. Appropriates moneys for pilot project. **Makes dental services provider in pilot project eligible for reimbursement for services provided to medical assistance recipient.**

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to dental pilot project; creating new provisions; amending section 2, chapter 716, Oregon  
3 Laws 2011; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
6 **ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the**  
7 **General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, which may be expended for extending the dental pilot**  
8 **project described in section 1, chapter 716, Oregon Laws 2011.**

9 **SECTION 2. A provider of dental services in a dental pilot project approved by the Oregon**  
10 **Health Authority pursuant to section 1, chapter 716, Oregon Laws 2011, is eligible to be re-**  
11 **imbursed for covered services provided to a recipient of medical assistance.**

12 **SECTION 3. Section 2, chapter 716, Oregon Laws 2011, is amended to read:**

13 **Sec. 2. (1) Section 1 [of *this 2011 Act*], chapter 716, Oregon Laws 2011, is repealed on January**  
14 **2, [2018] 2025.**

15 **(2) Section 17, chapter 716, Oregon Laws 2011, as amended by section 2, chapter 113,**  
16 **Oregon Laws 2013, is repealed January 2, 2025.**

17 **(3) Section 2 of this 2015 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.**

18 **SECTION 4. Section 2 of this 2015 Act applies to services provided on or after the effec-**  
19 **tive date of this 2015 Act.**

20 **SECTION 5. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
21 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**  
22 **on its passage.**
