

Senate Bill 660

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH CARE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to develop program for screening students in this state who are susceptible to tooth decay and providing dental sealants for those students.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Health Authority for purpose of funding program.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to providing dental services to children; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall develop a program for screening students in this state who are susceptible to tooth decay and providing dental sealants for those students. At a minimum, the program must:

(1) Screen and provide dental services to students in first, second, sixth and seventh grade; and

(2) Screen and provide dental services to students who attend schools in which at least 40 percent of all students attending the school are eligible for the United States Department of Agriculture's National School Lunch Program.

SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ for the purpose of funding the program described in section 1 of this 2015 Act.

SECTION 3. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect on its passage.
