A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to voter registration; amending ORS 247.420, 247.435 and 254.515.

- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- SECTION 1. ORS 247.420 is amended to read:

- 5 247.420. (1) A county clerk shall give a ballot marked "[Presidential] **Federal** only" to any per-6 son eligible under ORS 247.410 who personally appears in the office of the county clerk, completes 7 a registration card and verifies eligibility to vote under ORS 247.410.
- 8 (2) No person shall supply any information under subsection (1) of this section, knowing it to 9 be false.
 - **SECTION 2.** ORS 247.435 is amended to read:
 - 247.435. An elector of this state who moves to another state after the 31st day before a primary or general election for President or for electors of President and Vice President, and who does not qualify to vote in the state of the elector's present residence, may vote for these offices in the primary or general election in this state. The ballot for a person voting under this section shall be marked "[Presidential] Federal only."
 - **SECTION 3.** ORS 254.515 is amended to read:
 - 254.515. Ballots marked "[Presidential] **Federal** only" may be counted only for the offices for which the elector is entitled to vote. Votes on the ballot for other offices may not be counted.
