

Senate Bill 68

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee On Rules and Executive Appointments)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Secretary of State to conduct review of number of ballots returned by mail during 2014 general election that were received by county clerk after date of election.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State shall conduct a review of the number of ballots**
5 **returned by mail during the 2014 general election that were received by the county clerk af-**
6 **ter the date of the election.**

7 **(2) The secretary shall submit a report on the findings of the review described in sub-**
8 **section (1) of this section to the interim legislative committees on rules not later than Sep-**
9 **tember 15, 2015.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2015 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2015 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
